The affiliation of the corresponding author is used to determine eligibility for Read & Publish Open Access fee waivers, so please ensure that the corresponding author is agreed before you start the submission process.

Start the submission process

Once you are in the Author Area, click the "Submit a new manuscript" link.





Specify article type

Select your article type in the "Article Type" dropdown.

Confirm you have read the journal manuscript guidelines, publishing policies and Read & Publish details.

Click "Submit".

The "Author List" section

You need to add the name, institution and email for each author in the "Author List" section.

You also need to specify the corresponding author for your article.

To qualify for fee-free Open Access publishing, the corresponding author must be affiliated with an <u>institution which is</u> <u>participating in our Read & Publish initiative</u>.





The "Open Access" section

If your article is eligible for free Open Access publication under a Read & Publish agreement with a <u>participating institution</u>, select "Gold Open Access/CC-BY" <u>and</u> "Read & Publish fee waiver" in the "Questions" section of the submission process.

Post-submission peer review

Once you have submitted your article, it will undergo peer review.

We will let you know by email whether your article has been accepted for publication.

If it has been accepted, you will need to sign and return the Publication Agreement in your Bench>Press "Author Area".

We will then email you a link to our RightsLink system and, if the institution of the corresponding author is participating in our Read & Publish agreement, an automatic fee-waiver will be applied. Your article has been highlighted for Gold Open Access publication because you selected this option during submission. You may be eligible for free or discounted Open Access publication as part of our <u>Read & Publish</u> initiative. More details of this can be found below.

Your paper will be published under a Creative Commons (CC-BY) licence, made freely available from the journal website and deposited in PubMed Central for immediate release. The fee is \$4800/£3300/€3780, plus VAT if applicable (waivers may apply, see below). Confirmation of free Open Access publishing

You will receive a confirmation email as soon as the corresponding authors' institution confirms eligibility for free OA publishing under their Read & Publish agreement with us.

A PDF proof of your article will be sent to you for review, and the final approved version will be published under an Open Access CC-BY license.



Your article will be published Open Access.
